

# PHOTO CONTEST RULES

1. All entrants must be members of the BRHS or MPHS. Any member may enter an unlimited number of photos each of the four (4) categories. PHOTOS MUST HAVE BEEN TAKEN BY THE ENTRANT.
2. The Photo Contest categories are:
  - Black and White Print - Prototype
  - Black and White Print - Post-Merger Prototype
  - Color Print - Prototype
  - Color Print - Post-Merger Prototype
3. Post-merger prints must have subject matter that is of obvious Q or MOPAC or other predecessor road heritage. Locomotives, rolling stock and structures must clearly be of Q or MOPAC lineage and ownership.
4. Prints must not be smaller than 5"x 7", nor larger than 11"x 14". Photos must be mounted, but they must not be framed.
5. All prints must be titled, with the photographer's name, address, phone number and email address on the back. Nothing should appear on the front.
6. Prints will be assigned numbers at the time of entry and will be displayed in the Contest Room for the membership to view and vote upon by categories.
7. Voting will be done by popular vote.
8. Prints receiving the most votes will be the winners in their respective categories. First, second and third place ribbons will be awarded.
9. Only Society members who are registered participants of the Annual Meet are eligible to vote. Ballots will be furnished at the time designated by the Photo Contest Chair.
10. All photos must be claimed by the registered owners prior to the conclusion of the Annual Meet. The BRHS cannot be held responsible for unclaimed photos.
11. The BRHS and MPHS reserve the right to publish the winning photos in future issues of the ***BURLINGTON BULLETIN, ZEPHYR or EAGLE***. Winning photos will be retained by the BRHS for scanning and publication unless an electronic scan of the photo can be provided to the BRHS Editor at or after the meet. After scanning retained photos will promptly be returned to their owners.
12. The Societies and its Contest Officials will not be responsible for loss or damage to any photo entered in the contest.
