How to Use the New Updated BRHS Photo System

A few cool things that you might like to know about

The BRHS Photo System uses the term 'system' because it is more than a photo gallery. That's because it is integrated with other database systems on the BRHS web site.

Notice the two red circles on the screen capture to the right. If you click on either of those icons you will be linked to other features. The one next to the station name will take you to the station information page for Elsberry, MO. The icon next to the Fan Trip will take you to the web page for that fan trip.

The reverse is possible. At the bottom of the Station Details page and at the bottom of the Fan Trip Details page, if there are photos of the station or of the fan trip in the BRHS Photo System, there will be a thumbnail version of the photo in a list, along with some information. If the user clicks on any of the thumbnail images in the list, the reverse will happen. They will be taken to the in the BRHS Photo System View / Edit page for that station.

A few cool things that you might like to know about

The two link icons  are not always visible. Each one requires certain information to be populated or set on this View / Edit page.

[RED] For the link to the station record to be visible four things needed to be set. These are 1) the station name, 2) the state abbreviation, 3) 'Box H - Depots and Stations' must be checked and 4) the station FSAC number must be added to the FSAC-Station number field. There are a many photos that include a city and state location, but they are not photos of a station. That is why 'Box H - Depots and Stations' must be checked.

[GREEN] If a station name and state are added to the form, and the station is a valid CB&Q station in the database, you will find the FSAC number at the bottom of the page. This will not work for C&S or FW&D.

[BLUE] For the link icon to the Fan Trip web page to be visible, the fan trip ID number must be added.
